

Before Regular Council the Mayor held a Public Hearing for Ordinance #09-1939 ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO THE ZONING CODE AND SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS OF THE VILLAGE OF SUGARCREEK, OHIO. No one had anything for or against to say about the ordinance, so the Public Hearing was concluded.

Roll Call: Tim Brown, Arlen Hostetler, Craig Morris, Jeff Schrock, Linda Wilson, and Jacki Agler.

Agenda: The Mayor asked if there were any additions or corrections to the agenda. There were none so the agenda stood as typed.

Special Minutes: The Mayor asked if there were any additions or corrections to the minutes from the Special Meeting. There were none so the minutes stood as typed.

Minutes: The Mayor asked if there were any additions or corrections to the minutes. There were none so the minutes stood as typed.

Expenditures: Hostetler made a motion to pay list of bills, submitted by the Clerk-Treasurer, second by Wilson. Vote recorded: Yea 6, Motion carried.

Reports: Schrock made a motion to accept the reports, second by Morris. Vote recorded: Yea 6. Motion carried.

Morris made a motion to go into executive session to discuss compensation for an employee at 7:20, second by Agler. Vote recorded: Yea 6. Motion carried. At 7:40 Schrock made a motion to end the executive session, second by Morris. Vote recorded: Yea 6. Motion carried.

Morris announced that there would be a Finance meeting on Monday November 9th at 7:00 p.m. There also will be a Record and Retention meeting the same night at 6:00 p.m.

The Mayor would like to thank Belden Brick for the helping with the clean up from the annual bonfire. The Mayor also announced the retirement of Barb Glidden as Village Tax Administrator, effective November 30, 2009. Wilson made a motion to adopt the draft for the Public Records Policy, second by Morris. Vote recorded: Yea 6, Motion carried.

The Mayor announced that he had received an E-Mail from a Garaway Librarian stating that they feel that Patrolman Wood was a very good selection for the officer in the schools. This also showed during the death of Jeremy Lower.

Village Administrator: Rausch announced that there would be a meeting on November 16th at 6:00 p.m. with Tim Jackson from the mine subsidence, to discuss the mine issue up at Cherry Ridge. Tracy Brininger was not sure if he could attend or not at that time. Rausch also would like to thank Belden Brick for removing a pole located at the Y, being where Rt. 39 and Main St. meet. This was due to an accident, and the Street Department then replaced the pole.

Fire: Harrison announced that they would be having mandatory training held on November 24th for 6 hours, and December 15th for 3 hours. Harrison also announced that he has 3 new people that are interested in employment, Heather Eckert, Tim Eckert, and Jacob Mahaffey. All having paramedic experience, Schrock made a motion to hire all if they can pass the drug screen, second by Morris. Vote recorded: Yea 6. Motion carried. Harrison said that the Fire Department raised over \$1,000.00 at their latest Soup and Salad Supper held, and would like to thank those for their support.

Police: Acting Chief Kevin Kaser announced that Wood had just attended class, and Haver also will be attending a class on November 5th for 2 days. Kaser said that the Trick or Treat held on October 31st from 1-3 went very well.

Morris presented papers to Brown and Hostetler from Bart Miller, owner of the IGA store due to the railroad crossing being fixed. Morris said since they both were involved they should have this information, and take action on this with the funds lost.

Schrock said that he had talked to parents that were very pleased to have Trick or Treat during the day.

Agler asked the Mayor if the light situation was handled on the corner of Factory and St. Rt. 39. The Mayor's response was that the issue was not taken care of yet, but is still in the works.

Morris made a motion to adopt Ordinance #09-1940, as an emergency, second by Brown. Vote recorded: Yea 6, Motion carried.

Ordinance #09-1942 Titled: AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH THE TUSCARAWAS COUNTY PUBLIC DEFENDER COMMISSIIION FOR THE YEAR 2010 was read for the second time.

Having no further business Morris made a motion to adjourn, second by Wilson. Vote recorded: Yea 6. Motion carried.
